COACHES COLUMN:

2014 Winter State Age Championships

Willoughby Swimming Club was out in action at the 2014 Winter State Age Swimming Championships held at Homebush on the weekend of August 29th-31st. Whilst Willoughby was under represented in its usual depth, having only 8 swimmers competing, the quality of the performances from those 8 members was outstanding.

Leading the charge for Willoughby was Callum Lowe Griffiths who racked up 6 individual medals over the weekend and was well supported by Jacqui Schafer who scored individual gold medals in her 100 and 200 metre Backstroke events. Of the 8 swimmers competing, 5 swimmers won individual medals and our younger representatives whom included Daniel Gorgas, Daniel Sims and Amanda Crowe all showed why they have promising swimming careers ahead of them. Lucas Anderson and Ainslie Scott showed the benefits of consistent training throughout the entire winter season, achieving personal best performances in all of their individual events, and Ollie Sims swam exceptionally well despite a very limited preparation.
