### NSW WINTER STATE SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS 2015

On the 28-30<sup>th</sup> August Willoughby Swimming Cub was back in action at Homebush for the 2015 State Winter Swimming Championships. Willoughby Swim Club was well represented with 20 athletes who had been steadily preparing throughout the season for the opportunity to compete against the best swimmers in NSW. This is an age group meet where athletes compete against other swimmers within the same age group.

Medals at this level of competition don't come easily as both the level of competition is high and the depth is strong. Making their mark this week end by achieving medal performances included Hannah Baldwin, Emily Doyle, Gabriel Gorgas, Callum Lowe Griffiths, Jacqui Schafer and Daniel Sims and our 18 Years Women's medley relay team.

Overall Willoughby achieved 16 medals made up of 3 gold, 4 Silver and 9bronze. An excellent performance all round. Our club finished 14<sup>th</sup> on the club point score out of more than 100 clubs who represented at this competition.
